Just few steps to prepare your UNICAM mobility experience

To be nominated as exchange student you must contact your coordinator to check if there is an Erasmus or a Cooperation Agreement already signed between your home university and UNICAM.

The application process in **few** steps:

1. Nomination

The coordinator at your home university will send an official nomination to the International Office of UNICAM within 15 June for the first Semester (October-February,) 15 November for the second semester (March-July)

2. Confirmation

The coordinator, responsible for the International Mobility at University of Camerino will officially accept the nomination.

3. Application

The application, completely filled in, must include a copy in pdf format of the following documents

- Application form, signed and stamped
- Transcripts of records
- Learning agreement

4. Assessment

Your application will be assessed by UNICAM University school coordinators in charge of your application.

5. Letter of admission

Once the assessment is made and eventual changes on the Learning Agreement are agreed upon, a letter of admission will be issued.



Before leaving home be sure to have these documents:

- Passport or valid Identity Card (ID)
- Visa, if required
- Letter of acceptance or invitation from the University
- Confirmation of accommodation
- Health Insurance
- Documents demonstrating adequate economic means of support for your stay in Italy (applicable to non grant-holders)
- Some passport photos

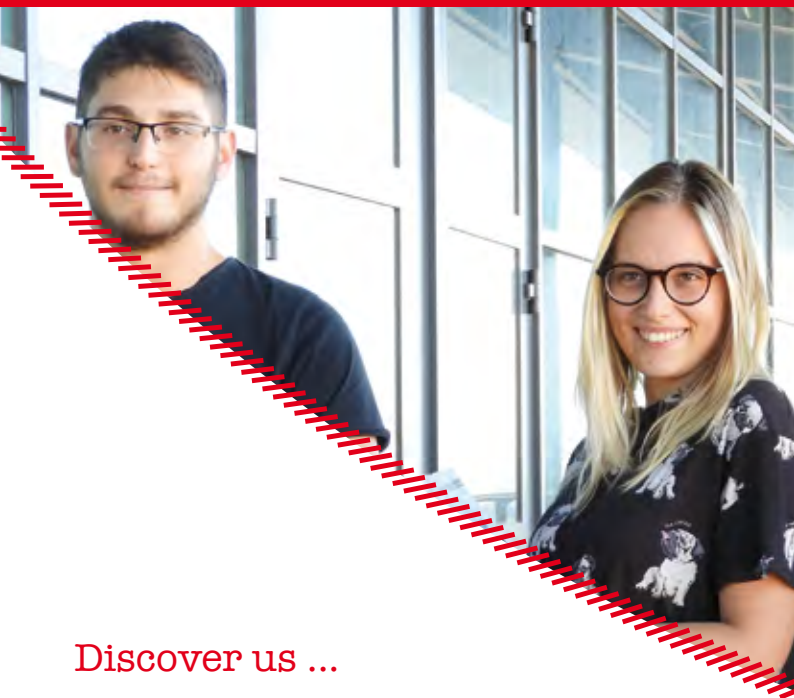
